Since the program began in 1991, the hunters of Virginia have donated in excess of 7.9 million pounds of meat, enough to provide 31.7 million quarter-pound servings of this quality food! And as a hunter I love donating deer as it is a wonderful way for me as a hunter to “give back” by sharing my harvest with those who are hungry. I encourage all hunters to participate; it’s a great way to help our fellow man and promote our hunting heritage in a positive way.”
